PARENTAL CONSENT AND LIABILITY RELEASE FORM

In consideration for _____ being accepted by First Congregational UCC for participation in _____ we (I) being 21 years or older do for our self (myself) (and for and on behalf of my child –participant if said child is not 21 years or age or older) do hereby release, forever discharge and agree to hold harmless First Congregational UCC and the directors thereof from any liability, claims or demands for personal injury, sickness or death, as well as property damage and expenses, of any nature whatsoever, which may be incurred by the undersigned and the child participant that occur while said child is participating in the above-described trip or activity.

Furthermore, we (I) (and on behalf of our (my) child participant if under the age of 21 years) hereby assume all risk of personal injury, sickness, death, damage and expenses as a result of participation in recreation and work activity involved herein.

Further, authorization and permission is hereby given to said church to furnish any necessary transportation, food and lodging for participant.

The undersigned further hereby agree to hold harmless and indemnify said church, its directors, employees and agents, for liability sustained by said church as a result of the negligent, willful or intentional acts of said participant, including expenses incurred attendant thereto.

We (I) authorize and adult, in whose care the minor has been entrusted, to consent to any X-ray examination, anesthetic, medical surgical or dental diagnosis or treatment, and hospital care, to be rendered to the minor under the general or special supervision and on the advice of any physician or dentist licensed under the provisions of the Medical Practice Act on the medical staff of a licensed hospital, whether such diagnosis or treatment is rendered at the office of said physician or at said hospital.

The undersigned shall be liable and agree(s) to pay all costs and expenses incurred in connection with such medical and dental services rendered to the aforementioned child pursuant to this authorization. Should it be necessary for our (my) child to return home due to medical reasons, disciplinary reasons or otherwise, the undersigned shall assume all transportation costs.

The undersigned does hereby give permission for our (my) child to ride in any vehicle designated by the adult in whose care the minor has been entrusted while attending and participating in the activities sponsored by First Congregational UCC.

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RULES OF CONDUCT FOR CHURCH OUTINGS

Because God calls us to be a community of faith and leaders in Christ's church, we need to conduct our life together at this outing in a manner that promotes a community of faith. Remember that while you are attending this outing you are a representative of First Congregational UCC, your community, and Jesus Christ. Please keep this in mind and behave accordingly. Violation of these rules could mean returning home at your own expense before the event's conclusion.

1. Any evidence of smoking or the possession and/or use of tobacco products by any minor at any time during this outing will not be tolerated.
2. Any participant found to be in possession/distribution or under the influence of alcohol would be expelled from this outing.
3. A participant found to be in possession/distribution or under the influence of drugs/non-prescription narcotics (cannabis, inhalants, hallucinogenic drugs, amphetamine intoxicants, stimulant drugs, etc.), or drug paraphernalia at any time will be expelled from this outing.
4. Any problem with any room, including, but not limited to, open use of tobacco, alcohol, or drugs/non-prescription narcotics, will be considered the action and responsibility of all students assigned to and/or present in the room at the time. The sponsors of the outing reserve the right to inspect any room, male or female, at any time if there is just cause.
5. Possession or use of a weapon or other object which may reasonably be considered a weapon, including toys, fireworks, chemical sprays, laser pointers, lighting devices, etc., or verbal threats of violence will result in expulsion from the outing.
6. A "zero tolerance" policy towards gambling, vulgar or abusive language or gestures, insolence, insubordination, fighting, sexual misconduct and harassment will be in effect throughout the outing.
7. A "zero tolerance" policy towards the possession or use of inappropriate media materials (books, magazines, videotapes, etc.) will be in effect throughout the outing. Inappropriate T-shirts will also not be tolerated.
8. Violation of curfew and "lights out" will not be tolerated.
9. Radios, CD players and hand held games will be allowed only with headphones or with the volume off.
10. Attendance is mandatory for all worship, devotions and Bible study activities.
11. All persons and property will be treated with dignity and respect. The facilities made available to use shall be treated with care. Upon leaving the facility all rooms and areas will be cleaned and left in the same shape as when we arrived.
12. There will be no food or snacks in the rooms.
