

Kranz Scholarship

The Selection Committee of this Scholarship is composed of members of First Congregational United Church of Christ in Eagle River, WI. Applicants need not be members of this church.

Who should apply:

- Applicants must be either graduating seniors from a Vilas County High School, residents of Vilas County, or demonstrate a compelling connection to Vilas County.
- Recipients must have been accepted by or be enrolled in an accredited public or private college. Recipients must be full-time students, undergraduate or graduate.
- Applicants must have a minimum grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.

The Application Process:

Applications must be received by Friday, March 23, 2018.

- The application form must be fully completed and include a one page essay outlining the applicant's reasons for applying, his/her career choice and the reasons for choosing it.
- The application must be accompanied by an official transcript of the student's academic record (High School grades 9 - 12, completed college courses) and three letters of reference for graduating high school students and two for students already in college.
- Applicants may be asked to interview in person with the Selection Committee.

Additional Information:

- The recipient's academic record, financial need, and potential work ethic will be considered.
- Scholarships will be paid to the college upon receipt of proof of registration for the semester ahead. One half of the scholarship will be paid at the beginning of each semester.
- For scholarships that are granted for more than one semester, proof of registration for the next semester and a transcript for the previous semester need to be submitted.
- Students must submit their grades and registration materials promptly before or at the start of the semester that the scholarship applies to. We will not send out reminders.
- Students who are awarded a scholarship and subsequently decide to take a gap year must forfeit their scholarship for that year, i.e. students who are awarded a scholarship for one year will not receive it at all and students who are awarded a four year scholarship will have to forfeit the scholarship for the year that they are not in school.
- Scholarship money that is not used in a given year due to the students taking a gap year will be awarded to the next applicant in line.
- The Scholarship Committee will review continuing grants each semester and may withhold the scholarship installment if the student should fail to quality. Reinstatement may be possible for subsequent semesters if the cause of the disqualification has been removed.
- Students who applied but did not receive a scholarship in one year may re-apply the next year.
- Students who received a one year scholarship may also re-apply the next year.
