- College Freshmen need to submit proof of registration for the first semester to the guidance Office at Northland Pines High School as soon as possible, latest during August 2021..
- If you are awarded a scholarship that extends over more than one semester, you will be required to submit the transcript of the previous semester and proof of enrollment and course listing for the semester ahead at the beginning of each semester for which you are to receive a scholarship.
- All correspondence should be addressed to the Guidance Office at Northland Pines High School.
- If your grades fall below the 2.75. average, your scholarship will be suspended. You have one semester to bring the grades back up in order to qualify for further scholarship support.
