Kranz Scholarship

Applicants must be either graduating seniors from a Vilas County high school, graduates of a high school in Vilas County (students already in college), or residents of Vilas County.

This scholarship usually grants one \$20,000 scholarship (payable as \$5.000 per year for up to four years) and, if available,) at least one additional scholarship of at least \$1,000



Bird Nest Scholarship

Applicants should be graduating seniors of a Vilas County high school or graduates of a Vilas County high school (students already in college), or homeschoolers. Applicants may be entering a four-year college, a technical college, or other career training leading to certification in a profession.

This scholarship usually grants three \$2,000 scholarships per year for up to four years.
